

Section 2. The sum by this Act appropriated shall be expended under the direction of the Commissioner of Education, and shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska upon warrants drawn upon the Treasurer by said Commissioner of Education, specifying the purpose for which warrants are drawn. How expended.

Section 3. The Commissioner of Education is hereby authorized to cause plans for such addition to be prepared, provide for the purchase and transportation of the material for such addition and improvements, and to enter into such contract for the work hereby authorized, as he finds proper, provided however, that all material purchased to carry out the provisions of this Act shall, in so far as practicable, be products of the Territory of Alaska. Contract and plans, by whom. Proviso.

Section 4. No part of the sum hereby appropriated, or any other Territorial monies, may be used for the purchase, rental or acquisition of the grounds on which such addition shall be built, and such ground must be furnished to the Territory without cost to the Territory. Grounds to be donated.

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. Emergency.

CHAPTER 85.

AN ACT

[H. B. 51]

Providing for the investigation and study of the warble fly, nose fly and other pests and parasites preying upon the reindeer herds of Alaska, making an appropriation therefor and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated from the Treasury of Appropriation in re reindeer pests.

the Territory of Alaska, to be expended under direction of the Governor in cooperation with the Department of Agriculture, said sum to be used for the purpose of making a study and investigation of the warble fly, nose fly and other pests and parasites which prey upon the reindeer herds of Alaska, with a view to eradicating such pests and parasites.

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately on its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 86.

AN ACT

[H. B. 56]

To authorize physical examinations of school children and to require parents and guardians to cause their children to be examined for diseases and exposures thereto, and to authorize the exclusion of children from school when suffering from, afflicted with, or exposed to disease, and authorizing the expenditure of school funds therefor, providing penalties for violations, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That school boards within incorporated municipalities are empowered and authorized to, and shall, at least once during each school year, cause a physical examination to be made by a competent physician or nurse of the pupils attending said school, and are authorized and empowered to, and shall, exclude from school attendance all children afflicted with or suffering from, or who have been exposed to, any contagious, infectious, obnoxious or communicable disease or diseases, and are authorized and empowered to, and shall, require, if in the judgment of the Terri-
