

CHAPTER 92.

AN ACT

[H. B. 94]

For the relief of the Town of Sitka in the restoration of a Russian Blockhouse in the Sitka National Monument at Sitka, Alaska, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Deficiency appropriation, Russian block house at Sitka.

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated from the monies in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$300.00 to cover the deficiency in the contract price for the restoration of a Russian blockhouse in the Sitka National Monument at Sitka, Alaska.

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 93.

AN ACT

[H. B. 99]

To reimburse E. G. Morrissey for money spent by him as U. S. Commissioner for the Rescue and Relief of Andy Johnson, a lost person, making an appropriation and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation to reimburse E. G. Morrissey.

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated out of the monies in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$100.00 to reimburse E. G. Morrissey for money spent by him while U. S. Commissioner at Ketchikan, Alaska, in searching for Andy Johnson, a lost person, which money can not be paid in the regular manner because the vouchers were not presented to the Governor in time.
