HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 8.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of Alaska, in regular session assembled, that the people of the Territory of Alaska speaking through their Legislature express their fullest confidence in the present Republican administration and in the policies and principles of the President of the United States, Herbert Hoover, believing that Mr. Hoover by his experience as a frontiersman and pioneer is well qualified to cope with the problems which confront this Territory. In his conduct of the high office of Secretary of Commerce, he has shown supreme ability to administer the most important industry of this Territory. His successful conduct of the many responsible positions held by him, is a guaranty of an efficiency and ability which the people of Alaska have every confidence will be directed to the development of the resources of the Territory.
