

CHAPTER 102.

AN ACT

[H. B. 120]

To appropriate for the expenses of the Territory of Alaska, for the biennium beginning April 1, 1931 and ending March 31, 1933, and for the school years commencing July 1, 1931 and ending June 30, 1932 and commencing July 1, 1932 and ending June 30, 1933, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The following sums or so much thereof as shall be found necessary, are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated for the expenses of the Territory for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 1931 and ending March 31, 1932 and for the fiscal year commencing April 1, 1932 and ending March 31, 1933.
