

## CHAPTER 107.

## AN ACT

[S. B. 79]

To amend Chapter 118, Session Laws of Alaska, 1929, by adding a new section relative to audits and repealing Subsection (k) of Section 16, Chapter 118, Session Laws of Alaska, 1929.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. Chapter 118, Session Laws of Alaska, 1929, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section after Section 28 to be numbered Section 28 A, to read as follows:

“Section 28 A. Every officer, Board and institution of the Territory shall submit the office records, files, accounts and transactions of the officer, Board or institution to the Governor for inspection and for audit by an expert accountant to be employed by the Governor. Such audit shall be made within thirty days before the expiration of such officer’s term of office or at such time as the Governor shall order. The expenses of the audit shall be paid out of the appropriation for contingent expenses of the treasurer’s office.”

Section 2. Subsection (k) of Section 16, Chapter 118, Session Laws of Alaska, 1929 is hereby repealed. The books, records, papers, files, accounts and transactions of every officer, board or institution in the Territory are public records, and subject to such reasonable rules as the officer in charge may prescribe, shall be open to inspection by the public during all the time the respective offices shall be open for business.
