

CHAPTER 115.

AN ACT

[H. B. 115]

Authorizing the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners to make a reconnaissance survey of a highway across Prince of Wales Island and making an appropriation therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Territorial Road Board authorized make recommendations for road on Prince of Wales Island.

Section 1. That the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners is hereby authorized to make a reconnaissance survey for a highway between settlements on the East Coast of Prince of Wales Island and settlements on the West Coast of said Island to determine the practicability and approximate cost of constructing such a highway.

Money allotted from First Division road funds.

Section 2. For the purpose of carrying into effect the provisions of this Act the sum of Fifteen Hundred (\$1500.00) Dollars or so much thereof as said Board of Road Commissioners shall deem fit to expend is hereby allotted from the moneys appropriated by the Tenth Session of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska and allocated to the First Judicial Division of the Territory of Alaska for the construction of roads, trails, bridges and ferries in the Territory of Alaska.

CHAPTER 116.

AN ACT

[H. B. 118]

To provide for the construction of school houses and provide funds therefor and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Commissioner of Education to have authority to provide for building of school houses.

Section 1. The Commissioner of Education with the approval of the Governor shall have authority to provide for the building of school houses and/or the acquisi-

tion of sites therefor at such places and at such cost as he shall find to the best interest of the public. Whenever the Commissioner of Education shall decide upon the erection of any school house he shall cause the proper plans and specifications therefor to be prepared, and shall have such school house constructed under contract let to the lowest responsible bidder after calls for bids have been circulated among persons or corporations likely to be interested in bidding; Provided, however, that no moneys shall be expended for the purchase of any site.

Bids.
No money for purchase of site.

Section 2. The sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00), or so much thereof as shall be necessary, is hereby appropriated, from the general fund of the Territory, not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of carrying into effect the provisions of section 1 of this Act. Warrants against this appropriation shall be drawn upon vouchers approved by the Commissioner of Education.

Disbursement.

Section 3. The limitation of the expenditure of Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00) upon the cost of school houses constructed by the Territory prescribed by section 43 of Chapter 97 of the laws of 1929 shall not apply to school houses constructed under the provisions of this Act.

Limitation under Sec. 43, Chap. 97, S.L.A. 1929 not to apply.

Section 4. Any part of the sum by this Act appropriated may be used for the construction of a school house or school houses in any incorporated town or city of Alaska the population of which is less than one hundred persons. Except as herein provided no part of the appropriation hereby made shall be used for the construction of any school house in any incorporated town or city of Alaska.

Act to apply to—

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect from and after its passage and approval.

Emergency.
