

CHAPTER 117.

AN ACT

[H. B. 121]

Appropriating \$25,000.00 to be expended in cleaning streams and for the destruction of predatory enemies of the salmon, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation
for cleaning
salmon
streams—

Section 1. That there is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the Territory of Alaska the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) to be expended under the direction of the Governor of Alaska, for the cleaning of salmon spawning streams and for the destruction of trout and other predatory enemies of the salmon.

Governor to
contract with
Bureau of Fish-
eries for work.

Section 2. The Governor of the Territory of Alaska is hereby authorized to enter into agreement with the United States Bureau of Fisheries whereby transportation of men and the costs of supervision of the work done under the above appropriation may be undertaken by said Bureau of Fisheries.

Residents only
hired.

Section 3. It is further provided that no person not a bona fide resident of the Territory of Alaska shall be employed under the provisions of this Act.

Emergency.

Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
