

CHAPTER 118.

AN ACT

[H. B. 7]

To amend Section 22 of Article V of Chapter 65, Session Laws of 1929, relative to the care and support of the destitute and needy.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 22 of Article V of Chapter 65, Session Laws of 1929, be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 22 of Art.
V, Chap 65,
S.L.A. 1929,

“Section 22. Expenses incurred by Territory Recoverable. Any money paid to or any expense incurred for any person pursuant to the provisions of Articles I, II, III, or IV of this Act shall with interest thereon at rate of eight per centum per annum from date of payment be an indebtedness owing the Territory by the beneficiary and such indebtedness may be recovered during the life of the beneficiary and shall be a first, prior and preferred claim against the estate of such beneficiary after his death, and after all just claims for food, clothing, fuel, shelter, medical aid or burial expenses have been paid.

That any moneys left in charge of the Board of Trustees by any deceased inmate of the Pioneers' Home may be used for the burial and funeral expenses of such deceased inmate and for the improvement of the burial plot of the Alaska Pioneers' Home.

Money left,

Any clothing or any other personal effects left by any deceased inmate of the Home may be used by the Board for the benefit of other inmates, or may be given to relatives or sold and the proceeds applied in the same manner as above provided for moneys left.
