

## CHAPTER 4.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 12]

To appropriate funds for payment of deficiencies in various appropriations heretofore made and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the Treasury of the Territory, or as much thereof as shall be necessary, for the purpose of paying the bounty on hair seals pursuant to Chapter 48 of the Laws of 1927. This appropriation is to be supplementary to the appropriation heretofore made for that purpose for the biennium ending the 31st of March, 1931.

Deficiency appropriation, hair seal bounty.

Section 2. The sum of Seven Hundred Dollars (\$700.00) is hereby appropriated from the Treasury of the Territory, or as much thereof as shall be necessary, for the purpose of paying contingent expenses of the office of the Territorial Treasurer. This appropriation is supplementary to the appropriation heretofore made for that purpose for the biennium ending March 31st, 1931.

Deficiency appropriation, Territorial Treasurer's office.

Section 3. The sum of One Hundred and Twenty-five Dollars (\$125.00) is hereby appropriated out of the Treasury of the Territory, or as much thereof as shall be necessary, for the purpose of paying for light, heat and contingent expenses for the Territorial Museum Building in the City of Juneau. This appropriation is supplementary to the appropriation heretofore made for said purpose for the biennium ending March 31, 1931.

Deficiency appropriation, Territorial Museum contingent fund.

Section 4. The sum of Seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) is hereby appropriated from the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, or as much thereof as shall be necessary, for the purpose of paying clerical assistance and necessary contingent office ex-

penses of the Commissioner of Health. This appropriation is supplementary to the appropriation heretofore made for the same purpose for the biennium ending March 31st, 1931.

Emergency.

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 5.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 2]

To repeal Sections 753, 754, 755, 756, 757, 758, 759, 760, 761 and 762, of the Compiled Laws of the Territory of Alaska, 1913, relating to limited partnerships.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Repeal.

That Sections 753, 754, 755, 756, 757, 758, 759, 760, 761 and 762 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1913, be, and the same are, hereby repealed, except as affecting limited partnerships formed prior to the enactment of Chapter 71, Session Laws of Alaska, 1917.

Exception.

## CHAPTER 6.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 3]

To amend Chapter 32 of the Session Laws of Alaska for 1923, relating to Foreign Corporations.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 660 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska 1913, as amended by Chapter 32 of the Session Laws of Alaska for the year 1923, "An Act
