

CHAPTER 41.

AN ACT

[H. B. 37]

To amend Section 59, Chapter 97, of Alaska Session Laws 1923, and to provide for the classification of property for municipal tax purposes, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Sec. 59, Chap.
97, S.L.A. 1923,
amended.

Section 1. That Section 59, of Chapter 97, Alaska Session Laws 1923, be hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

Classification
of property for
tax purposes.

“Provided further that the council by its general ordinance may classify the different kinds of property for tax purposes.”

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 42.

AN ACT

[H. B. 58]

Providing for the sale of bonds and superfluous personal property belonging to the Territory.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Bonds pur-
chased by
Territory may
be sold, by
whom, condi-
tions—

Section 1. Any bonds which have been or may hereafter be purchased by the Treasurer for the benefit of the Territory from any funds set apart for any specific purpose, may be sold by the Treasurer at such terms and under such conditions as the Governor may approve, and the moneys so received shall be placed to the credit of the fund for which such bonds were purchased.

Section 2. That whenever any personal property belonging to the Territory shall have become superfluous or of no further use to the Territory, the same may be sold in such manner and on such terms as the Governor shall approve, and the moneys received for such property at such sale shall be covered into the Treasury of the Territory. Provided, however, that this shall not be construed to prevent old and worn office furniture or office supplies to be traded in part exchange for new ones of the same general character.

Superfluous Territorial property may be sold.

Money covered into Treasury.

Proviso.

CHAPTER 43.

AN ACT

[H. B. 60]

To authorize advertisement of the advantages of construction of the proposed International Highway between Fairbanks, Alaska, and Seattle, Washington, and making an appropriation therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the Alaska Road Commission is hereby authorized to advertise the advantages of the construction of the proposed automobile highway between Fairbanks, Alaska, and Seattle, Washington, through Yukon Territory and British Columbia, in such manner as such commission may deem advisable and to expend therefor not to exceed the sum of One Thousand Dollars during the current biennium.

Alaska Road Commission to advertise International Highway.

Limitation of expenditure.

Section 2. For the purpose of carrying into effect the provisions of the foregoing section the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or so much thereof as shall be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the general fund of the Territory not otherwise appropriated, and it shall be the duty of the Auditor to draw warrants against this appropriation in payment
