

CHAPTER 45.

AN ACT

[H. B. 65]

To provide for the maintenance of carrier pigeons for use in aviation, making an appropriation, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. For the purpose of aiding aviation and increasing the safety thereof, the Governor shall have authority to establish and maintain a carrier pigeon loft at such place or places in the Territory as he shall deem of greatest advantage, to secure for the same the necessary pigeons and make such arrangement for the training and the use of the same as he shall find to best serve the purpose for the attainment of which such pigeons are secured and kept. Maintenance of carrier pigeon lofts.

Section 2. The sum of Twenty-five Hundred Dollars (\$2500.00), or so much thereof as shall be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the general fund of the Treasury of Alaska to pay the expenses incurred in carrying into effect the provisions of section 1 of this Act, and the same shall be disbursed in payment of vouchers approved by the Governor. Appropriation. How disbursed.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect on and after the date of its passage and approval. Emergency.
