

## CHAPTER 46.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 66]

To amend Section Five (5) of Chapter 31, Alaska Session Laws of 1917, entitled an Act providing a Relief Fund for the rescue and relief of persons lost while prospecting, boating, hunting, or otherwise, in the Territory of Alaska, and declaring an emergency therefor.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section Five (5), Chapter 31, Session Laws of Alaska of 1917, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 5. "In all cases where there is no United States Commissioner, the Postmaster at such place shall be, and he hereby is required to perform the duties required of the United States Commissioners as prescribed in Section Three (3) and Four (4) of this Act, and the Postmaster shall be paid the same fees as United States Commissioners are paid under this Act and Acts amendatory thereto for services rendered in connection therewith, and in such cases the vouchers may be sworn to before the said Postmaster and the voucher for the Postmaster's services signed by him and witnessed by two witnesses and the said vouchers paid upon approval of the Governor.
