

## CHAPTER 47.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 72]

To appropriate Three Hundred Thirty (\$330.00) Dollars for the benefit of the City of Juneau, Alaska, and to reimburse it for transporting pupils to and from points along the Glacier Highway from and to the Juneau Public Schools, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The sum of Three Hundred Thirty (\$330.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated out of the Territorial Treasury for the benefit of the City of Juneau, Alaska, to reimburse the latter for actual expenses incurred in transporting pupils to and from points along the Glacier Highway from and to the Juneau Public Schools during the school year of 1930-1931, and the Auditor of the Territory is hereby directed to draw a warrant against this appropriation in favor of the City of Juneau, Alaska, for the sum of Three Hundred Thirty (\$330.00) Dollars in reimbursement of said cost of transportation.

## CHAPTER 48.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 86]

To appropriate \$300.00 for payment to Lawrence Kerr for services performed by him for the Territory in 1929, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) is hereby appropriated from the general fund of the Territory for the payment of Lawrence Kerr

for services which he performed for the Territory in 1929 at the request of the Legislature. This sum shall be paid to him by warrant in his favor drawn by the Auditor upon the Treasurer of the Territory.

## CHAPTER 49.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 46]

To amend Section 1865 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska relative to the competency and credibility of witnesses.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Sec. 1865,  
C.L.A.,  
amended.

Section 1. That Section 1865 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska relative to the competency and credibility of witnesses be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Competency and  
credibility of  
witnesses.

“Sec. 1865. Neither parties nor other persons who have an interest in the event of an action or proceeding are excluded as witnesses; nor those who have been convicted of crime; nor persons on account of their opinions on matters of religious belief; although in every case, except the latter, the credibility of the witness may be drawn in question, according to the rules of the common law. When a party to a civil action or suit by or against an executor or administrator appears as a witness in his own behalf, statements of the deceased whether oral or in writing concerning the same subject may also be shown.”
