

day of each month, file with the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners, a schedule for the previous month, setting forth in detail the number of men employed, and wages paid on such work, and furnish such other information as the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for the Territory of Alaska may request.

Section 5. Should any part of this Act be declared <sup>Validity of Act.</sup> invalid, it shall not invalidate the remainder of the Act.

Section 6. An emergency is hereby declared, and <sup>Emergency.</sup> this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 69.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 68]

Creating a commission to make survey of the facilities and recommend a program for care of dependent children, and making an appropriation.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The Governor shall appoint a commis- <sup>Committee to investigate methods, etc., re care of dependent children, and report—</sup> sion of five (5) members whose duty it shall be to make a survey of the facilities available in the Territory and the methods now employed for the care of dependent children, to make inquiries to determine the best methods now in use in the states covering the subject, and to report its findings and recommendations for a territorial program to the next regular session of the Legislature.

Section 2. The commission shall have authority to <sup>Clerical assistance, etc.</sup> employ the necessary clerical assistance and to incur the necessary contingent office expenses.

Appropriation.

Section 3. The sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or so much thereof as shall be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the general fund of the Territory not otherwise appropriated to carry this Act into effect, which sum shall be paid on vouchers approved by the Governor.

## CHAPTER 70.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 20]

To authorize the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners of Alaska to construct an automobile and wagon road which will connect the City of Anchorage with the settlement of Eklutna in the Third Judicial Division, and to employ for that purpose Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) of the road funds apportioned to said Third Judicial Division under the provisions of Section 5 of Chapter 11 of the Laws of 1919, and to provide for co-operation between the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners and the Alaska Road Commission, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for the Territory of Alaska, is hereby authorized to construct an automobile and wagon road which will connect the City of Anchorage with the settlement of Eklutna in the Third Judicial Division of the Territory of Alaska; that in the performance of said work and in the construction of said road, the said Board shall expend not to exceed the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) during the ensuing biennium, but any portion of said sum may be expended upon said project irrespective of the total estimated cost thereof; that said Board shall not obligate the Territory of Alaska for the performance of said work in excess of the amounts which the Leg-
