

Pioneers' Home, and the Territorial Highway Engineer. The duties of such commission shall be to investigate the cost of construction, equipment and operation of a permanent home for Alaska pioneer men, or pioneer men and women, as contemplated by House Joint Resolution No. 2 passed by the Legislature of 1927 and have tentative preliminary plans prepared for the construction of such building or buildings for submission, together with their other findings, to the regular session of the Legislature for 1933. The Commission shall also make the necessary investigations to determine the proper location of such Home and the status of the title to the land on which such Home is to be constructed and the proper means of acquiring title thereto, and report thereon to the regular session of the Legislature for 1933.

Commission to report to Legislature.

Section 2. The Commission shall have authority to employ all necessary clerical assistance and incur other necessary contingent office expense, including actual necessary expenses for travel and subsistence.

Expenses of Commission.

Section 3. The sum of Twenty-five Hundred Dollars (\$2500.00), or so much thereof as shall be needed is hereby appropriated out of the general fund of the Territory not otherwise appropriated for the purpose of carrying into effect the provisions of this Act, which sum shall be paid on vouchers approved by the Governor.

CHAPTER 75.

AN ACT

[H. B. 43]

To reimburse the City of Fairbanks for repairs made to the waterfront and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500.00), or so much thereof as may be neces-

sary, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, for immediate and future reimbursement of the City of Fairbanks, Alaska, for repairs made or to be made to the waterfront of said city along the Chena River.

Extent of reimbursement.

Section 2. Such reimbursements shall be made only to the extent of fifty percent (50%) of the actual expense incurred and only upon such portion of any repairs that are or may be done that were or are necessary and attributable to the damage done by the flood of 1930, and shall be so adjudged and approved by the Territorial Highway Engineer.

Amount adjudged and approved, by whom.

How paid.

Section 3. The Territorial Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to pay the said sum hereby appropriated, or so much thereof as may be required, to the City of Fairbanks, upon the approval of the Territorial Highway Engineer.

Emergency.

Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 76.

AN ACT

[H. B. 44]

To amend Section 1 of Chapter 51 Session Laws of 1925, entitled "An Act to provide for stocking public lands in the Territory of Alaska with certain valuable game and fur-bearing animals which do not already frequent such lands, providing for the protection of such animals, making an appropriation to carry out the provisions hereof, and declaring an emergency," as amended by Chapter 32 Session Laws of 1927 as amended by Chapter 98 Session Laws of 1929.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:
