

covenants or conditions of the mortgage, the attaching creditor may foreclose the same, as provided in Section 749; and it is hereby made the duty of the United States Marshal or any deputy, at the request of said creditor and upon being furnished with sufficient bond as provided in Section 749, to take possession of all the property described in said mortgage and sell the same in the manner prescribed by law for the sale of personal property under execution, and the proceeds of such sale shall by said officer be applied first to the costs of the foreclosure proceedings, next to the repayment to the attaching creditor of the sum paid to the mortgagee or assignee thereof, and retain the balance pending the final proceedings in said action or the orders of the court. The execution of a redelivery bond by the defendant or the discharge of the attachment by an order of the court shall not affect the rights of the attaching creditor under this Section."

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist Emergency. and this Act shall take effect upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 79.

AN ACT

[H. B. 69]

Authorizing the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for the Territory of Alaska to build a bridge at or near the Town of Seldovia, Alaska, providing for the payment of said work, providing for cooperation with the citizens of said Town of Seldovia, and declaring an emergency to give this Act immediate effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for the Territory of Alaska is hereby authorized to construct a bridge or causeway, sixteen feet in

width and extending from the southern approach of the Anderson Dock in Seldovia, Alaska, in a westerly direction approximately, along the line of mean high tide toward the sawmill for a distance of approximately two thousand feet at a reasonable elevation above the high water mark.

Amount authorized to be expended.

Section 2. In the performance of said work, that said Board is authorized to expend not to exceed the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) during the succeeding biennium of which at least one half shall be expended during the year 1931, of which said fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00) shall be contributed by the citizens of the said Town of Seldovia before the commencement of said work.

Town of Seldovia to contribute.

Authorized expenditure to come from Third Division road fund.

Section 3. The sum of twelve thousand five hundred dollars (\$12,500.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby allotted from the moneys appropriated by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska at the Tenth Session of said Legislature and allotted to the Third Judicial Division of the Territory of Alaska for the construction and maintenance of roads, trails, bridges and ferries in the Territory of Alaska for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this Act. Provided that the moneys appropriated or apportioned under this Act may not be expended except that after investigation to determine the feasibility of its constructions and maintenance as a factor in the development or service of the Territory affected the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners shall approve the project.

Proviso.

Emergency.

Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
