CHAPTER 81.

AN ACT

[H. B. 71]

Authorizing the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for the Territory of Alaska, in conjunction with the Town of Cordova, Alaska, to construct a hydroplane port or mooring within five miles of said Town of Cordova, Alaska, providing for the payment of said work and declaring an emergency to give this Act immediate effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The Territorial Board of Road Commissioners for the Territory of Alaska is hereby authorized to construct a hydroplane port or mooring within five miles of the Town of Cordova, Alaska, and on Eyak Lake, adjoining said Town. Hydroplane port or mooring for Cordova.

Section 2. In the performance of said work, said board is authorized to expend not to exceed the sum of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) of which sum the Town of Cordova shall deposit to the credit of the Territorial Road funds for the Third Division, the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 110 of the Session Laws of 1929. Authority for expenditure—share of town of Cordova.

Section 3. Said work shall be done under the direction of the said Territorial Board of Road Commissioners either under contract or by day labor as said Board may see fit and under plans and specifications to be prepared by the Highway Engineer of the Territory of Alaska. How work is to be done.

Section 4. The sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) or as much thereof as may be necessary is hereby allotted from the moneys appropriated to the Third Division of the Territory of Alaska for the construction and maintenance of roads, trails, bridges and ferries in the Territory of Alaska for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this Act. Provided that the moneys appropriated or appor- tioned under this Act may not be expended for the purposes hereinafter set forth except that after inves- tigation to determine the feasibility of its construction and maintenance as a factor in the development or service of the Territory affected the Territorial Board of Road Commissioners shall approve the project.

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 82.

AN ACT

[H. B. 74]

To appropriate the sum of \$436.86 to pay the balance of salary due Miss Gladys E. Merilatt for teaching in the Point Aggazis School District, First Judicial Division of the Territory of Alaska, during the year 1928-29, with interest for one year at the rate of 8% per annum, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of \$436.86 is hereby appro- priated out of the funds of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, to pay Miss Gladys E. Merilatt the balance of the salary due her from the Point Aggazis School District in the First Judicial Division of the Territory of Alaska for teaching dur-
