

Section 4. Payment for the service herein provided Payment.  
 for shall be made upon vouchers approved by the Governor monthly upon receipt by the Governor of proof by the affidavit of the owner or operator of the station so broadcasting, that the station has during the month covered by the voucher complied with the requirements of this Act and has furnished the service stated in said voucher.

Section 5. The sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,- Appropriation.  
 000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the Territorial Treasury not otherwise appropriated to carry out the provisions of this Act.

Section 6. An emergency is hereby declared to exist Emergency.  
 and this Act shall be effective from and after the date of its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 87.

AN ACT

[H. B. 108]

To amend Chapter 99 of the Laws of 1929 relative to Municipalities of the second class.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. Section 4 of Chapter 99 of the Laws of 1929 is hereby amended so as to read as follows: Sec. 4, Chap. 99.  
S.L.A. 1929  
amended.

“That the election herein provided for shall be by printed or written ballot in substantially the following form, to-wit:

‘For incorporation as a city of the second class of the city of ..... Form of  
ballot.

(insert name of proposed corporation)

‘or

'Against the incorporation of a city of the second class  
of the city of .....  
(insert name of proposed corporation).'

Trustees,  
how many.

"The qualified electors of the community proposed to be incorporated shall also at the same election by a separate ballot choose five trustees who shall be qualified electors of the community.

Judges of elec-  
tion to certify  
result to Dis-  
trict Court.

"The judges of election shall certify to the District Court the result of the election giving the number of votes cast in favor of incorporation and the number of votes cast against incorporation, as well as the number of votes cast for each person for the office of trustee.

Order of incor-  
poration or  
non-incorpora-  
tion.

"As soon as such certificate is received by the District Court the Judge thereof shall enter an order declaring the community incorporated as a city of the second class if a majority of the votes cast was in favor of such incorporation, otherwise the Judge shall make an order declaring the community not incorporated. Such order shall also declare the five who received the highest number of votes for trustees elected to those offices.

Subsequent elections of trustees shall be held on the first Tuesday of April each year, and the trustees shall hold office for the term of one year and until their successors are elected and qualified."
