CHAPTER 90.

AN ACT

[S. B. 51]

Providing for the installment and operation of a radio telephone system and making an appropriation therefor, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The Governor of Alaska shall have authority to establish a radio telephone system connecting an appropriate station or stations now included in the Washington-Alaska Military Cable and Telegraph System with as many as practicable of the following communities in the Second Judicial Division of Alaska, viz., Marshall, Taylor and Haycock, to provide for the operation and maintenance of the same, to promulgate rules and regulations for the use of such telephone system, prescribe the fees to be charged for service and do whatever else is necessary for the successful operation of such system.

Fees to be cov-
ered into Terri-
torial treasury.

Section 2. All fees collected for the use of such telephone system shall be covered into the Treasury of the Territory, where it shall constitute a separate and distinct fund which shall at all times be at the disposal of the Governor for the purpose of paying expenses connected with the maintenance and operation of said telephone system. Such fund shall be disbursed in payment of vouchers approved by the Governor.

Section 3. That the Governor shall have authority to arrange for co-operation by the United States Signal Corps and/or the Alaska Road Commission in the installation of such telephone system and/or operation of the same, and to make such other arrangement therefor as he shall deem of greatest advantage to the Territory.

Governor authorized arrange for co-operation in installation.

Section 4. The sum of seven thousand dollars (\$7,000.00) or so much thereof as shall be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the general fund of the Territory, not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of installing, maintaining and operating the radio telephone system described in Section 1 of this Act. In addition to the above sum, there is hereby appropriated for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this Act, the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) from the monies allotted or to be appropriated and allotted to the Second Judicial Division, Territory of Alaska, for the construction of roads, trails and bridges, which sum shall be expended only after the amount first provided for in this Act shall have become exhausted. Such sum shall be paid on vouchers approved by the Governor, and the entire appropriation, or so much thereof as the Governor shall find necessary, may be transmitted to the disbursing officer of Washington-Alaska Military Cable and Telegraph System, or to the disbursing officer of the Board of Road Commissioners for Alaska for disbursement to pay the cost or expenses of the said installation, maintenance and operation.

Provided, that the monies appropriated or apportioned under this Act may not be expended except after an investigation to determine the feasibility of its operation and maintenance as a factor in the development or service of the territory affected, the Governor shall approve the project.

Emergency.

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 91.

AN ACT

[S. B. 62]

Creating the office of superintendent of Public Works for the Territory of Alaska, prescribing the duties thereof, providing compensation for the performance of such duties, and declaring an emergency to give this Act immediate effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Creating office
of Superintend-
ent of Public
Works.

Section 1. The office of Superintendent of Public Works for the Territory of Alaska is hereby created. Until otherwise provided by law, the Territorial Highway Engineer of the Territory of Alaska shall be ex-officio the Superintendent of Public Works. For performing the duties of said office the Superintendent of Public Works shall be paid a salary of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) a year in twelve equal monthly installments, and his term of office shall commence May 1, 1931.

Duties.

Section 2. It shall be the duty of the Superintendent of Public Works when so requested by any Territorial officer to supply plans, specifications and estimates for all school houses and other public buildings and public works in the Territory of Alaska; to advise the territorial officers with respect to the erection, construction and repair of all public buildings, and other public works; to inspect from time to time, and to superintend generally, the construction of all public buildings and other public works; to require the provisions of all contracts for such construction to be faithfully complied with; and to perform such other
