## CHAPTER 96.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 110]

To amend Section 12 of Article 3 of Chapter 97 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1923, relating to the power and jurisdiction of municipal councils, by adding sub-section 21 thereto, authorizing common councils to prescribe the qualifications of persons operating and driving, and to license and regulate the use and operation of, and to fix the fares that may be charged for the transportation of passengers in, taxi-cabs and other for-hire automobiles and vehicles, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That section 12 of Article 3 of Chapter 97 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1923, is hereby amended by adding thereto and as a part thereof sub-section 21 as follows:

Licensing,  
regulating etc.  
of motor  
vehicles.

TWENTY-FIRST: By general ordinance to provide for the licensing and regulating of the use and operation of motor vehicles within the municipality and to prescribe the qualifications of persons operating on or driving such vehicles; to classify motor vehicles and to prescribe special qualifications for persons operating or driving taxi-cabs, for-hire automobiles, motor busses or other vehicles for the transportation of passengers or baggage; to regulate the operation of all such vehicles; to fix the fares that may be charged for the transportation of passengers and baggage within the

municipality; and to designate through or one-way streets.

Provided, that all licenses, regulations, qualifications and fares prescribed by the council shall be fair and reasonable.

Proviso.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 97.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 113]

To amend Section 3, Chapter 77, Session Laws 1915, being an Act "Creating the office of Attorney-General of the Territory of Alaska."

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 3, Chapter 77, Session Laws of Alaska, 1915, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 3, Chap. 77,  
S.L.A. 1915  
amended.

"Section 3. Duties: The Attorney-General of Alaska shall be the official legal advisor of the Governor, the Treasurer, the Secretary, and other officers of the Territory. He shall bring, prosecute and defend in the name of the Territory, all necessary and proper actions or suits for the collection of the revenue under Territorial laws; he shall file informations and prosecute all offenses against the revenue, and other laws of the Territory, prosecution of which is not otherwise provided for; he shall when requested by the Legislature or any member thereof, give legal advise [advice] concerning any law or proposed law or legislative measure; he shall take cognizance of all memorials passed by the Territorial Legislature, shall urge on the various
