

## House Joint Resolutions

### HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, William P. Rauch generously bequeathed to the Alaska Territorial Historical Library and Museum the sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), which sum is now available for the use of the said institution,

Now, Therefore, Be It

RESOLVED that the Territorial Historical Library and Museum Commission is hereby instructed to employ the William P. Rauch legacy to secure for the museum a collection of Indian basketry representative of the best workmanship of the several aboriginal tribes of the Territory, which collection shall thereafter be forever known and designated as "THE WILLIAM P. RAUCH COLLECTION."

### HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 2.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, there have arisen certain conflicts in the laws of the Territory of Alaska,

WHEREAS, it appears to the Legislature that certain adjustments are necessary in order that the business of the Territory may be more efficiently managed,

Now, Therefore, Be It

RESOLVED, that a joint Committee of the House and Senate be appointed, said Committee to consist of four members of each House of which the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House be members, which said Committee shall have the duty, right and authority to examine into the conduct of all Territorial Offices, to hold hearings and to keep a record of all testimony thereof, and to subpoena
