HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 1.

RESOLVED that the House of Representatives has heard with profound regret of the death of the Honorable John W. Dunn, late a member of the Senate from the Fourth Division; that in the death of Senator Dunn the people of Alaska have lost a faithful public servant and one who by his outstanding personal virtues, his honesty, integrity and courage, justly earned the respect and affection of all.
