

Proviso: The Banking Board is hereby authorized to sell the bonds at any time they deem advisable, Provided, however, that should a contingency arise at any time necessitating the sale of said bonds, and the Territorial Banking Board be unable to sell same for the full par value, there shall be no liability attached against the bond of the Territorial Treasurer for any loss sustained by the sale of said bonds, unless due to the carelessness, negligence or collusion of the Treasurer. The bonds when so sold by the Banking Board shall be transferred to the purchaser without recourse against the Territory.

#### SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 4.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska that the committees of Printing and Purchasing of the Senate and House, acting jointly, shall have five hundred (500) copies printed of the report of the Territorial Highway Engineer for the Biennium of 1929-31, and that such expense be covered in the General Appropriation Bill.

#### SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 5.

WHEREAS, Radio Station KFQD of Anchorage, Alaska, has applied to the Federal Radio Commission for increase of power from one hundred (100) to five hundred (500) watts; and

WHEREAS, said station is well constructed and efficiently managed and operated and it is performing a very valuable public service in Alaska by the broadcasting of information to men who reside in remote sections and have no other convenient means of obtaining news from the outside world; and

WHEREAS, the operation of said station is particularly vital in connection with transportation by air in the vast and sparsely settled regions of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, an increase of power if granted to said station would enable it to further increase its usefulness and expand the meritorious service which it is now rendering to the public; therefor [therefore] be it,

RESOLVED that the Legislature of Alaska in its Tenth Regular Session assembled, does hereby approve and endorse the application of said Station KFQD for increase of power from one hundred (100) to five hundred (500) watts and respectfully prays and petitions that said increase may be granted.

RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Federal Radio Commission, a copy to the Delegate for Congress from Alaska, and a copy to Station KFQD at Anchorage.

### SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 6.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE TERRITORY OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, the American Legion, Department of Alaska, held a Flag contest throughout the Schools of Alaska, and;

WHEREAS, the winning design was adopted by the Legislature of Alaska as the official flag of Alaska, and;

WHEREAS, a fund has been established for making up the official flag to be used under the direction of the Governor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Governor of Alaska on behalf of the Territory of Alaska, is hereby authorized to present the American Legion, Department of Alaska, with an official flag of Alaska as a fitting appreciation of their interest and activity in conducting the above mentioned contest.
