

Senate Resolutions

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 1.

RESOLVED that the Senate has heard with profound regret of the death of the Honorable John W. Dunn, late a member of the Senate from the Fourth Division; that in the death of Senator Dunn the people of Alaska have lost a faithful public servant and one who by his outstanding personal virtues, his honesty, integrity and courage, justly earned the respect and affection of all.

RESOLVED that as an additional tribute of respect to the memory of the deceased, the Senate stand adjourned for the day.

RESOLVED that these resolutions be spread upon the Journal of the Senate and that a copy thereof be transmitted to the House.

SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 2.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate that a vote of thanks be extended to the Governor, Secretary, Treasurer, Attorney General, Auditor and Commissioner of Education of the Territory of Alaska for their valuable assistance in compiling reports pertaining to their respective offices and submitting the same to the Legislature.
