

## CHAPTER 10.

## AN ACT

[S. B. 16]

To amend Sections 511 and 512 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1913.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 511 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1913, be, and the same is, hereby amended to read as follows:

Execution of  
deed in foreign  
country.

“Section 511. If such deed be executed in any foreign country it may be executed according to the laws of such country and the execution thereof acknowledged as provided in Chapter 66, Session Laws of 1915.”

Section 2. That Section 512 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, be, and the same is, hereby amended to read as follows:

Acknowledg-  
ments of  
married women.

“Section 512. All acknowledgments of married women to conveyances of real property in this Territory shall be taken in the same manner as if they were unmarried.”

## CHAPTER 11.

## AN ACT

[S. B. 17]

To amend Section 657 Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1913, providing a penalty for non-compliance by foreign corporations of designated statutory provisions.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That the last sentence of Section 657 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1913, be, and the same is, hereby amended to read as follows:
