

CHAPTER 110.

AN ACT

[S. B. 127]

To amend sub-section 10th, Section 1, Chapter 59, of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1927, relative to a tax on fresh fish purchased.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That sub-section 10th, Section 1, Chapter 59, of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1927, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

“10th. Fish buyers (dealers in fresh fish) one-tenth of one cent per pound on fish purchased in excess of four hundred thousand pounds, except for sale at retail, whether or not the fish buyer operated a cold storage plant.”

CHAPTER 111.

AN ACT

[S. B. 72]

Authorizing the purchase of supplies in Alaska whenever practicable.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. In making purchases or awarding contracts for supplies, commodities or materials for any office or institution of this Territory preference shall be given, whenever practicable, to producers and dealers in the territory, price and quality being equal.
