

CHAPTER 112.

AN ACT

[S. B. 122]

To amend Section 6, Chapter 111, Session Laws of Alaska, 1929, providing for holding examinations for admission to the bar.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 6 of Chapter 111 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1929, be, and the same is, hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 6. The Board of Law Examiners shall hold examinations at such places and at such times as the Attorney General may direct; Provided, that examinations may be held in each judicial division under the supervision of the resident law examiner and without the presence of any other member of the board; the questions submitted to any applicant at such examination shall first be approved by the board, or a majority of its members, and the answers thereto shall be graded by the board, or a majority of its members acting separately and certified to the District Court of the Division in which the examination is held.”

- (b) Liens on chattels for work or repair;
