

CHAPTER 34.

AN ACT

[S. B. 49]

To repeal Chapter 24, Session Laws of 1915, dealing with Indian Citizenship; Chapter 39, Session Laws, 1915, providing fees for filing affidavits of annual labor on mining claims, and Chapter 70, Session Laws of 1915 dealing with forfeiture of mining claims for lack of annual labor or failure to file affidavit of annual labor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Chapters 24, 39 and 70 of the Session Laws of 1915 be, and the same are, hereby re-^{Repeal.}pealed.

CHAPTER 35.

AN ACT

[S. B. 52]

To amend Section 2, of Chapter 2, Session Laws, 1913, by adding a proviso to said Section 2, providing for the issuance of any writ or order on legal holidays.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 2, of Chapter 2, of the Session Laws of 1913, be, and the same is, hereby amended by adding a proviso so as to read as follows:

“Section 2. No Court shall be open nor shall any judicial business be transacted on a legal holiday, except: 1. To give, upon request, instructions to a jury then deliberating to their verdict. 2. To receive the verdict of a jury. 3. For the exercise of the powers of a magistrate in a criminal action or in a proceed-

Courts to be closed on legal holidays, except—

ing of a criminal nature. 4. For hearing an application for writ of Habeas Corpus. PROVIDED, That this Section shall not be so construed as to prevent the issuance of any writ or order for which the Judge granting the same shall find that an emergency exists."

CHAPTER 36.

AN ACT

[S. B. 57]

To repeal Chapters 13, 47 and 72 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1917.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Repeal.

Section 1. That Chapter 13 of the Session Laws of 1917, being an Act to create a fund for the purpose of detecting crime, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

Repeal.

Section 2. That Chapter 47 of the Session Laws of 1917, being an Act authorizing the maintenance of a Bureau of Publicity, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.

Repeal.

Section 3. That Chapter 72 of the Session Laws of 1917, being an Act permitting the United States or the Territory of Alaska, to sue out a Writ of Error, in certain designated cases, be, and the same is, hereby repealed.
