

## CHAPTER 76.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 82]

To amend Chapter 59 of the Session Laws of 1927 by adding thereto Sub-section 19 and amending Section 2 of same Chapter, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 1 of Chapter 59 of the Session Laws of 1927 be amended by adding thereto Sub-section 19 to read as follows:

“19. Itinerant traders and dealers selling merchandise in the Territory of Alaska, five per cent (5%) of their gross sales.”

Section 2. That Section 2 of Chapter 59 of the Session Laws of 1927 be amended to read as follows:

“Section 2. This Act shall not have the effect to release or extinguish any penalty, forfeiture or liability incurred under existing law. Itinerant traders and dealers as mentioned in Sub-section 19 who leave, or attempt to leave, the Territory without having paid the five per cent (5%) license tax shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be punished by imprisonment not less than thirty (30) days nor more than six (6) months, or by a fine of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.”

Penalty.

Section 3. An emergency existing therefor this Act shall be in effect from and after its passage and approval.
