

CHAPTER 87.

AN ACT

[S. B. 24]

To repeal Chapter 44, Session Laws of 1919, being an Act to provide for the election of a Board of Trustees for the local government of towns and communities on public domain under the control of the Land and Industrial Department, and providing that all communities organized under the provisions of said Chapter shall be deemed to be municipal corporations organized under the provisions of Chapter 97, Session Laws of 1923, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Chapter 44 of the Session Laws of 1919, be, and the same is, hereby repealed. Repeal.

Section 2. All communities heretofore organized under the provisions of said Chapter 44, Session Laws of 1919, shall be held and deemed to be organized and existing under the provisions of Chapter 97, Session Laws of Alaska, 1923, and all amendments thereto, and the same shall be and constitute municipal corporations within the meaning of said last named Chapter, and the qualified electors therein shall elect a mayor, common council and school board as therein provided. Such mayor, council and school board shall perform the duties and exercise the powers therein set forth, and such corporations shall have and enjoy all the privileges, rights and powers as though originally organized pursuant to the provisions of said Chapter 97 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1923. Incorporated towns deemed to exist under Municipal Code.
Powers and duties of officers.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval. Emergency.
