The term of office of a notary public shall be four years from and after the date of his commission, but he may be sooner removed by the governor for misconduct in office.

CHAPTER 9.

AN ACT

[S. B. 15]

To amend Section 550 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1913, declaring void the transfer of personal property in certain cases.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 550 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1913, be, and the same is, hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 550. All deeds of gift, all conveyances and all transfers or assignments, verbal or written, of goods and chattels or things in action, made in trust for the person making the same, shall be void as against the creditors, existing or subsequent, of such person.”

Conveyances or assignments in trust void against creditors of persons making same, when.
