

CHAPTER 90.

AN ACT

[S. B. 83]

To amend Section 4, Chapter 43, Session Laws of Alaska, 1925, providing for the foreclosure of a lien to secure payment of the sale's profit tax.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 4 of Chapter 43 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1925, be, and the same is, hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 4. If a tax be found due an action to foreclose the lien therefor shall be commenced by the Territory within six months from the date of the receipt of such report by the Treasurer but no lien shall bind any property for a longer period than six months after the date of the receipt of said report by the Treasurer, unless the same be false or incorrect.

CHAPTER 91.

AN ACT

[S. B. 88]

To provide for the protection of game and fur bearing animals stocked by the Territory; to provide punishment for taking or killing the same; to repeal Section 4, Chapter 51, Session Laws of Alaska, 1925.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. Whenever the Territory has stocked, or shall hereafter stock, any lands with game animals, game birds or fur bearing animals, they and their offspring shall be and remain the property of the

Treasurer to foreclose lien within given time.

Governor to declare birds and animals public property, when.
