

## CHAPTER 95.

## AN ACT

[S. B. 101]

To amend Section 7, Chapter 40, Session Laws of Alaska, 1921, fixing the time to claim escheated property.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 7 of Chapter 40 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1921 be, and the same is, hereby amended by striking therefrom, in line one, the word "ten" and insert in lieu thereof the word "seven".

Section 2. That said Section 7 of said Chapter 40 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1921, be, and same is hereby, further amended by striking therefrom, in line 8 the word and figure "twenty (20)" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "thirty".

## CHAPTER 96.

## AN ACT

[S. B. 102]

To amend Section 2, Chapter 28, Session Laws of Alaska, 1929, providing for the recovery of escheated property of fraternal organizations.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 2 of Chapter 28 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1929, be, and the same is, hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation having any claim or interest in, to or against such money or property, must bring an action to enforce such claim or interest within seven years after such corporation

or organization becomes defunct. In default thereof such money or property shall escheat to the Territory absolutely."

## CHAPTER 97.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 107]

To amend Chapter 17, Session Laws of Alaska, 1917, as amended by Chapter 40, Session Laws of Alaska 1925, by adding a section thereto granting a civil remedy for the recovery of damages sustained by reason of the negligent destruction of a shelter cabin or its contents.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Chapter 17 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1917, as amended by Chapter 40 of the Session Laws of Alaska, 1925, be, and the same is, hereby amended by adding thereto a Section to be marked Section 2, to read as follows:

Damages,  
liability for.

Section 2. Any person guilty of violating any of the provisions of the foregoing section shall be answerable in damages for any injury sustained by any person as a result of such wilful destruction of or injury to a shelter cabin or its contents."
