### SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 5.

WHEREAS, the Governor of Alaska has submitted to the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska the names of three trustees for the Alaska Agricultural College and School of Mines and the names of five persons to be the Board of Education of the Territory of Alaska.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska and the House of Representatives concurring that a joint session of the Alaska Territorial Legislature be held on May Second, 1933, at 2 P. M. in the Chambers of the House for the purpose of considering the appointments aforementioned and confirming or rejecting the same.
