

LAWS OF ALASKA

CHAPTER 1.

AN ACT

[H. B. 4]

To appropriate funds for payment of deficiencies in various appropriations heretofore made, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The following sums of money are hereby appropriated from the treasury of the Territory, or as much thereof as shall in each case be necessary, for the purposes stated below, which appropriations are to be supplementary to the appropriations heretofore made for the same purposes:

Deficiency
appropriation
for biennium
ending March
31, 1935.

For Auditor.

(a) Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for contingent expenses of the office of the Auditor of Alaska for the biennium ending March 31, 1935.

Vital Statistics.

(b) One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for payment of fees to United States Commissioners for recording vital statistics during the biennium ending March 31, 1935.

For Treasurer.

(c) Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) for payment of salaries and traveling expenses of tax collection clerks, office of the Territorial Treasurer, for the biennium ending March 31, 1935.

For bounty
on eagles.

(d) Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) for the payment of bounty on eagles for the biennium ending March 31, 1935.

(e) Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00) for payment of bounty on hair seals for the biennium ending March 31, 1935. For bounty on hair seals.

(f) Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00) for the payment of bounty on wolves and coyotes for the biennium ending March 31, 1935. For bounty on wolves and coyotes.

(g) Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) for the payment of allowances to aged residents for the biennium ending June 30, 1935. For aged residents.

(h) Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) for relief of destitution for the biennium ending March 31, 1935. For relief of destitution.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval. Emergency.

CHAPTER 2.

AN ACT

[S. B. 3]

To make uniform any reference to or citation of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The compilation of the Laws of Alaska, entitled "Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933," compiled, codified, annotated and published under authority of Chapter 50, Session Laws of Alaska, 1931 and Chapter 126, Session Laws of Alaska, 1933, be and the same is hereby declared to be prima-facie a compilation of all the statute law of Alaska.
