Now therefore be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriating \$1,125.00 to pay Oscar Olson for services in office of Treasurer.

Section 1. That the sum of \$1125.00 be, and the same is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the Treasury to pay the compensation of Oscar Olsen, for services performed and to be performed by him in the office of the Treasurer commencing the second day of January, 1935, and expiring on the last day of March, 1935.

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act is to be in force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 10.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 28]

To amend Section 2383 Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to general powers of councils in municipal corporations, by adding Sub-sections Sixteenth a and Sixteenth b thereto; and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Amending law with reference to municipal corporations.

Section 1. That Section 2383 Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to general powers of Municipal Council in Incorporated Cities and Towns in Alaska be and the same is hereby amended by adding to Sub-section Sixteenth, Sub-sections Sixteenth a and Sixteenth b to read as follows:

Sub-section Sixteenth a. To regulate the location of buildings or structures, designate the size, height and materials used therein and direct the use for such structures; and the Council may divide the town or municipality into zones or districts of such number and size as may by said council be deemed best suited for the needs; and the council may prohibit placing or keeping of offensive refuse, garbage or other unsightly or objectionable matter upon vacant lots or property within said municipality.

Power to regulate building and to provide for zoning districts.

Sub-section Sixteenth b. To condemn buildings and on thirty days legal notice to the owner or his agent cause their demolition where they have become a fire hazard or public nuisance or detrimental to the general beautification of the city. In the event of refusal to remove the objectionable building or buildings by the owner the cost incurred by the city in such removal shall be chargeable to the property.

Condemnation proceedings.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage and approval.

## CHAPTER 11.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 22]

To amend Sections 1931, 1932, 1933, 1934, 1935 and 1936, Compiled Laws of Alaska 1933, relating to the legislative department and providing for the publication of session laws of Alaska; this Act to have immediate effect upon its passage and approval.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Sections 1931, 1932, 1933, 1934, 1935 and 1936, Compiled Laws of Alaska 1933, be and
