

CHAPTER 17.

AN ACT

[H. B. 48]

To appropriate the sum of Fifty-six Dollars and Forty Cents (\$56.40) to reimburse W. E. Muller, Master of the Schooner "VENUS" for expenses incurred in the search for the trolling boat "THELMA", and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation
to reimburse
W. E. Muller.

Section 1. The sum of Fifty-six Dollars and Forty Cents (\$56.40) is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in the treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, as reimbursement to W. E. Muller, Master of the Schooner "VENUS", for expenses incurred by him in connection with the search for the gasboat "THELMA" on November 29, 1933, off Cape Muzon, in the southern end of the First Judicial Division.

Emergency.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 18.

AN ACT

[H. B. 60]

Authorizing the Territorial Treasurer to make refund to Alfred Torgersen, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, it appears that Alfred Torgersen, of Kodiak, Alaska, on September 20, 1933, paid \$100.00 to the Territory of Alaska, through the Office of the

District Clerk, in and for the Third Division, for a Beer License, No. B and W 19, to operate a bottling works from September 20, 1933 to June 30, 1934, and

WHEREAS, Federal regulations and Internal Revenues Laws affecting brewery regulations, made it impossible for the said Alfred Torgersen to construct and operate such bottling works, and

WHEREAS, equity will recognize the principle of justice, it is but consistent with the principles of equity, that the license tax be refunded, if the business for which the license was secured cannot be used because of subsequent legal regulations, THEREFORE,

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska, be and he is hereby authorized to refund to Alfred Torgersen, the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) out of money not otherwise appropriated.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall be effective immediately upon its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 19.

AN ACT

[H. B. 55]

Providing payment for R. C. Loudermilch for the burial of James Bolton, an indigent, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. The sum of Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75.00) is hereby appropriated for the payment of R. C. Loudermilch, proprietor of the Anchorage Funeral Par-
