

Section 3. The Governor of Alaska is empowered and it is made his duty, to allot to incorporated towns and cities, and to localities and districts outside of incorporated towns and cities, such amounts from the sum hereby appropriated, as conditions may require, the Governor shall be the sole arbiter of the amounts to be allotted to any town, district or locality.

Governor to allot monies to various localities.

Section 4. No part of the money appropriated under the provisions of this Act, shall be expended for relief of destitution in any incorporated city or town, unless such incorporated city or town shall first have made available and placed at the disposal of the Governor of Alaska, a sum equal to 50 per cent of the amount proposed to be expended in such city or town, under the provisions of this Act, and all monies so made available by any city or town shall likewise be expended under the direction of the Governor, for the relief of destitution in such city or town.

No monies appropriated to incorporated towns unless said town contribute an amount equal to 50 per cent of monies spent by Governor.

Section 5. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect upon its passage and approval.

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## CHAPTER 21.

### AN ACT

[S. B. 24]

To supplement Chapter XXIV Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, by adding a Paragraph to Sec. 1900 relating to trial jurors.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1900. That Section 1900 of Chapter XXIV of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be supplemented by adding thereto the following:

Court may reject name of trial juror,—when.

“At any drawing of jurors the Court or Judge may, by an order made at the time of such drawing reject the names of persons drawn whose attendance, in the opinion of the Court or Judge, cannot be obtained within a reasonable time, or whose attendance may involve a large and unnecessary expense.”

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## CHAPTER 22.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 23-24-25-26]

Specifying the time on which the Attorney General, the Treasurer, the Auditor, the Highway Engineer and other officers of the Territory shall qualify and enter upon duties of their respective office, repealing all Acts in conflict herewith, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

When elective  
officers take  
office.

Section 1. That the Attorney General of the Territory of Alaska, the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska, the Auditor of the Territory of Alaska, the Highway Engineer of the Territory of Alaska and other officers of the Territory, shall qualify and enter upon the duties of their respective offices on the first day of April, immediately following their election.

Repeal.

Section 2. All Acts and parts of Acts in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Emergency.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
