## CHAPTER 26.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 68]

Amending Section 1287 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, permitting pay for the resident member of the Territorial Board of Education.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 1287 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Compensation  
of members.

Sec. 1287. Compensation. Each member of the Board of Education shall receive his actual traveling expenses and subsistence while attending a meeting of the Board, and in addition thereto, the sum of Ten Dollars per day for each day such member is actually and necessarily absent from his place of residence as a result of his attendance at Board meetings. The member of the Board living in the town in which the meetings are held shall receive pay at the above rate for the number of days on which he attends meetings of the Board. Per diem and traveling expenses of the Board members shall be paid by warrants drawn on the Territorial Treasurer against the appropriations to be made to cover expenses and salaries of the Board of Education.
