

CHAPTER 30.

AN ACT

[H. B. 63]

To provide for the certification of teachers in private and denominational schools in the Territory of Alaska, for the examination of eighth grade pupils for graduation in private and denominational schools, and for the submission of monthly attendance reports and annual reports from private and denominational schools to the office of the Commissioner of Education.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Teachers to
secure cer-
tificates.

Section 1. That all teachers in private and denominational schools in the Territory of Alaska, teaching in grades from the kindergarten to the twelfth grade inclusive, shall secure certificates for teaching in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Territorial Board of Education.

Commissioner of
Education to
furnish ex-
amination
questions for

Section 2. That the Commissioner of Education is authorized to furnish final examination questions for the eighth grade pupils in private and denominational schools and grant eighth grade diplomas in the same manner as is done in the public schools of Alaska.

Private schools
to make
monthly reports.

Section 3. That teachers and others in charge of private or denominational schools shall make regular monthly attendance reports and annual reports to the office of the Commissioner of Education as is now done by teachers and superintendents in the public schools of Alaska.

Act effective
July 1, 1935.

Section 4. This Act shall become effective beginning with July 1, 1935.
