

ers approved by the Mayor of the City of Nome by the Commissioner of Education, specifying the purpose for which such warrants are drawn.

Section 3. The monies appropriated by Section 1 of this Act shall become available for the purposes herein stated whenever the duly organized school board and City council of the said City of Nome shall, by competent evidence prove to the satisfaction of the Commissioner of Education, that the said City of Nome has expended the sum of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000.00) in the construction and equipping the school house in said City; it being the intention of this Act that the Territory shall pay one-fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the cost of the school house and the necessary school equipment for the same, not to exceed the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) upon the condition that the City of Nome shall pay the entire remainder.

CHAPTER 35.

AN ACT

[H. B. 135]

To amend Section 2236, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relating to the Territorial Medical Board.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

That Section 2236, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2236. Powers and authority of Board: The said medical board shall have authority to prescribe and

establish all needful rules and regulations to carry into effect the provisions of this chapter, which rules and regulations shall be written or printed and preserved in the records of the office of the secretary-treasurer. And the members of said board shall each receive for each day actually engaged in the duties of their office as compensation the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars, together with all legitimate expenses incurred in attending the meeting of the board. All money collected by the board shall be paid into the Treasury of the Territory. The necessary expenses of the board shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Territory upon a warrant drawn by the Auditor of Alaska, which warrant shall be issued upon the order of the secretary-treasurer of said board. But such warrant shall be paid only from a fund specifically appropriated for the purpose, on the presentation of an itemized statement from said medical board of its receipts and expenditures.

CHAPTER 36.

AN ACT

[S. B. 8]

To amend Section 1501 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, relative to Primary Elections and the Declaration of Candidacy therein.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

That Section 1501 of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:
