

## CHAPTER 38.

## AN ACT

[S. B. 19]

To amend the first paragraph of Section 1539 Compiled Laws of Alaska 1933, (An Act to provide a method of voting for absentee electors and to prescribe penalties for the violation of the provisions thereof. Section 9, Chapter 89, Session Laws of Alaska 1931); To repeal Section 17, Chapter 89, Session Laws of Alaska, 1931, and to extend the provisions of said Sections to Primary Elections.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The first paragraph of Section 1539, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, (Section 9, Chapter 89, Session Laws of Alaska, 1931) is hereby amended to read as follows:

Absentee voters ballots. Section 1539. On the second Tuesday after each primary and general election said judges of election shall meet in the office of the said clerk at 2 o'clock in the afternoon of said day, and shall count and canvass all absentee voters ballots that have been received. Such canvass shall be conducted in the following manner:

To apply to primary elections. Section 2. All of the provisions of Article IV (Section 1531 to 1546) Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, are hereby extended to and shall apply as fully to Primary Elections as they apply to General Elections."

Repeal. Section 3. Section 17, Chapter 89, Session Laws of Alaska 1931 is hereby repealed.
