

CHAPTER 40.

AN ACT

[S. B. 33]

To amend Section 2007, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, providing a lien for labor performed upon mining claims.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 2007, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Lien on
mining claims.

“Section 2007. Labor deemed performed at instance of owner or mortgagee unless notice posted. When the work or labor mentioned in sections 2002, 2003 and 2005 of this article is performed at the instance of any person, firm or corporation, having the right of possession under a written or verbal lease, license or authority, expressed or implied, bond, option or other contract of sale from the owner, executed by his authority, or having possession with the knowledge of the owner, such work shall be deemed to have been done at the instance of the owner, and at the instance of any mortgagee or lien claimant, and such owners, mortgagee's or claimant's interest therein shall be subject to any lien filed in accordance with the provisions of this article, unless such owner, mortgagee or claimant shall, within ten days after he shall have obtained knowledge of such work or labor being performed, give notice that he will not be responsible for the same, by posting notices to that effect in three conspicuous places on such mine, mining claim, or on, or near such oil, gas or other well, or in one conspicuous place on such dredge, steam shovel, derrick, mill or machine, and, in the case of a mortgagee or other lien claimant, give additional notice of the nature of the lien, the amount due thereon, and refer to the volume and page where his claim of lien is recorded.
