CHAPTER 44.

AN ACT

[H. B. 38]

To reimburse Dr. R. V. Ellis of Ketchikan, Alaska, for medical services rendered to Axel Christiansen, an indigent; making an appropriation therefor, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation
reimbursing
Dr. R. V. Ellis.

Section 1. That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, out of the general funds in the Territorial Treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of Three Hundred and Thirty (\$330.00) Dollars, to reimburse Dr. R. V. Ellis of Ketchikan, Alaska, for medical services rendered to Axel Christiansen, an indigent, of Craig, Alaska, upon authority and order of J. A. Peters, U. S. Commissioner, Craig, Alaska.

Treasurer

Section 2. The Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska is hereby authorized to pay the amount herein above specified to said Dr. R. V. Ellis.

Emergency.

Section 3. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
