

## CHAPTER 45.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 84]

To make an appropriation of One Hundred Eighty-Nine and 50/100 Dollars (\$189.50), to pay the costs in the matter of the search for U. H. McDowell, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. The sum of One Hundred Eighty-Nine and 50/100 Dollars (\$189.50) is hereby appropriated out of the funds of the Territory of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, to compensate for expenses incurred and services rendered in the matter of the search for U. H. McDowell, made by John Lake and others, between July 15 and July 20, 1933; said appropriation to be paid on vouchers approved by the Governor of Alaska, and to the following persons and in the following amounts:

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act shall take effect from and after its passage and approval.
