

CHAPTER 5.

AN ACT

[H. B. 27]

To appropriate the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) to assist the City of Nome, Alaska, in the maintenance of its public grade and high schools, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Appropriation
for Nome
school.

Section 1. That the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) is hereby appropriated out of the funds in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, to assist in the maintenance of the public grade and high schools of the City of Nome, Alaska, as hereinafter provided.

For period
ending March
1, 1937.

Section 2. This appropriation shall be made to cover a period of two years beginning March 1, 1935, and ending March 1, 1937. The sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) shall be made available March 1, 1935, and a like sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) shall be made available March 1, 1936.

Treasurer to
pay school
board.

Section 3. These respective sums of money stipulated in Section 2 shall be paid at the dates stipulated in Section 2 by the Treasurer of the Territory of Alaska to the School Board of the City of Nome, Alaska.

Emergency.

Section 4. An emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall take effect immediately after its passage and approval.
