

CHAPTER 56.

AN ACT

[H. B. 75]

To appropriate Fifteen Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-Three Dollars (\$15,883.00) to pay claims against the Territory of Alaska for hospitalization, medical services and for other purposes, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of Fifteen Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty-Three Dollars (\$15,883.00) is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the Treasury of the Territory of Alaska not otherwise appropriated, to cover the following claims against the Territory of Alaska:—

Appropriation to pay claims for hospitalization, etc.

Maynard Hospital, Nome, Alaska	\$ 615.00
Seward General Hospital, Seward, Alaska	2,779.00
Sister's of St. Ann, Juneau, Alaska	2,139.80
Ketchikan General Hospital, Ketchikan, Alaska	2,349.80
St. Joseph's Hospital, Fairbanks, Alaska	6,610.25
City of Anchorage, Anchorage, Alaska	1,389.15

Payment for services under this appropriation shall be made only upon vouchers properly itemized, and approved by the Governor of Alaska, and no such voucher shall include any claim for expenses incurred subsequent to February 15, 1935.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval. Emergency.
