

## CHAPTER 57.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 133]

To amend Section 3138, Paragraph 1st. (b), Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

That Section 3138, paragraph 1st, (b), Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

“1st. (b) Undertakers, conducting a business in a town of more than five hundred inhabitants, one hundred dollars per annum.”

## CHAPTER 58.

## AN ACT

[H. B. 134]

To amend Section 3138, paragraphs 3, 4 and 5, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

That Section 3138, Paragraphs 3, 4 and 5, Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Sec. 3138. 3. Any person, firm or corporation selling electricity for light, power and other purposes and/or steam for heating purposes and supplies therefor, three-fourths of one percent. of the gross receipts in excess of twenty-five hundred dollars per annum from

light, power and steam sold; three-fourths of one percent. of the net profits from supplies sold, but this tax shall not apply to plants owned by municipalities.

"4. Telephone companies, three-fourths of one percent. of gross receipts in excess of fifteen hundred dollars per annum; but this tax shall not apply to plants owned by municipalities. <sup>Telephones.</sup>

"5. Water-works selling water or power to the public, three-fourths of one percent. of gross receipts in excess of twenty-five hundred dollars per annum; but this tax shall not apply to plants owned by municipalities. <sup>Water.</sup>

## CHAPTER 59.

### AN ACT

[H. B. 99]

To amend Section 1743, Chapter XXVII of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:*

Section 1. That Section 1743 of Chapter XXVII of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 1743. Contribution by community benefitted. No radio telephone station shall be established at any place unless the inhabitants of the community in which it is to be established, or the community residing adjacent thereto shall contribute twenty-five per cent of the landed cost of the equipment and of the installation thereof and agrees to contribute if necessary, to <sup>Radio tele-  
phones.</sup>
