

light, power and steam sold; three-fourths of one percent. of the net profits from supplies sold, but this tax shall not apply to plants owned by municipalities.

"4. Telephone companies, three-fourths of one percent. of gross receipts in excess of fifteen hundred dollars per annum; but this tax shall not apply to plants owned by municipalities. ^{Telephones.}

"5. Water-works selling water or power to the public, three-fourths of one percent. of gross receipts in excess of twenty-five hundred dollars per annum; but this tax shall not apply to plants owned by municipalities. ^{Water.}

CHAPTER 59.

AN ACT

[H. B. 99]

To amend Section 1743, Chapter XXVII of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That Section 1743 of Chapter XXVII of the Compiled Laws of Alaska, 1933, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 1743. Contribution by community benefitted. No radio telephone station shall be established at any place unless the inhabitants of the community in which it is to be established, or the community residing adjacent thereto shall contribute twenty-five per cent of the landed cost of the equipment and of the installation thereof and agrees to contribute if necessary, to <sup>Radio tele-
phones.</sup>

the maintenance of the station except that where any community shall satisfy the Highway Engineer that it has a satisfactory power plant available, the value of such plant, as assessed by the Highway Engineer shall be deducted from the community's contribution to the cost of installation and operation.

The Highway Engineer is hereby authorized to enter into agreements with the United States Post Office Department for the installation and maintenance of radio telephones under the charge of the Post Masters in the Communities where such radio telephone stations may be installed."

CHAPTER 60.

AN ACT

[H. B. 104]

To appropriate Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or as much as may be necessary, to be expended by the Governor of Alaska in securing insurance on the Uptown Theatre property, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. That the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or so much as may be necessary, out of the funds of the Territory of Alaska, not otherwise appropriated, is hereby appropriated to be expended under the direction of the Governor of Alaska for the purpose of securing insurance on the Uptown Theatre Building, on Lot Four (4), Block Eight (8), Townsite of Juneau, Alaska.
