CHAPTER 61.

AN ACT

[H. B. 110]

To require Administrative Officers or Employees to secure permission from the Administrative Board before incurring expenses for travel away from headquarters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Territory of Alaska:

Section 1. No expenses for travel of Administrative Officers or Employees of the Territory of Alaska, shall be paid out of the funds of the Territory, unless the said Officer or Employee submits to the Administrative Board of the Territory of Alaska, a verified written detailed application of his reasons for making such trip and unless the Administrative Board approved said application by an order in writing for making such trip, no expenses therefor shall be paid. Provided, however, that should the emergencies of the case be such that said Administrative Officer or Employee cannot procure the written order approving said trip before making the same he shall within thirty days after making said trip submit his verified application to the said Administrative Board for its approval and unless that approval is made in writing no expense for said trip shall be paid. All applications for making said trips and the orders ratifying the same shall be filed with the Auditor of the Territory of Alaska.

Administrative officers, etc. No travel expense allowed without approval board.
